Welcome

If you are interested in 4WD activities, you have come to the right place! The Oklahoma Trailchasers 4WD Club Inc. is dedicated to safe and responsible 4WD activities with a family atmosphere. Details about our club are provided below, so read on!

The Oklahoma Trailchasers were founded in 1990 as an Oklahoma City, Oklahoma-based club and is open to any type 4WD vehicle. We currently have about forty members from throughout Oklahoma and surrounding states. Our members have a wealth of experience with many different vehicles, and are willing to help others upgrade their vehicles. Even if you lack experience or knowledge, we can help you.

Activities

The club holds a general meeting each month, except for December. We have trips each month to locations throughout Oklahoma and surrounding states. Many runs are overnight with lodging in motels or camping according to individual preferences. Some trips are shared activities with other clubs and associations. We set up occasional parties according to members' desires and host an annual Christmas party for club members and their families and friends.

Newsletter

The club publishes our newsletter, *The Trailchaser*, each month. It highlights club activities, run photos, schedules, informative articles, and any items that members may want to buy, sell, or trade.

Trail Runs

We run trails suitable for stock vehicles to the most extreme trails, which require a lifted vehicle with oversized tires, lockers, and a winch. Many stock vehicle owners make modifications to allow them to navigate the more difficult trails.

For your safety, as well as the safety of your passengers and fellow club members, your vehicle must have the following minimum equipment:

- Seat belts for each passenger.
- First-aid kit.
- Roll bar or factory steel top.
- Tow attach points front and rear.
- Full-size spare tire (no space savers).
- Fire extinguisher (type BC minimum).

Safety Education

The United Four Wheel Drive Associations (UFWDA) developed the Four-Wheel Drive Awareness Program. We have customized this internationally recognized course for our area and long-standing Trailchasers members, who are certified instructors, teach the course.
